### **It's Easy to Sign-up and Report your Results**

1. A WSH Membership is required to sign-up for NWBZ Working Horse Division Year End Awards (see Horse Show sign-up form)
2. Once your Recording Form is received, you will begin earning points for your Year-End Awards.
3. After you compete at an event, ask the show secretary to sign your Exhibitor Reporting Form to verify the class name, number of exhibitors in the class, and your placing in the class.
4. Within 30 days of your event, submit your signed and completed Exhibitor Recording form to the NWBZ Horse Show Chairman.

### **Recognizing Your Success**

**High Point Awards will be awarded to the highest scoring Horse/Rider combination in the above events with at least three qualifying sign-ups.**

**A Working Horse Division Overall High Point Champion will be awarded to the horse/rider who has earned the most total points in one or more events. Sponsored by Kent's Nursery.**
