From I-5 Northbound, Exit 231, go around roundabout to bridge, cross over freeway. At second roundabout, turn onto Josh Wilson Rd. (Second Right)
Turn right at first stop sign (Farm to Market Rd).
Take the first left (Rector Rd) and the first right (Persons Rd) and you're here.
From Southbound, take exit 231, take third right out of roundabout onto Josh Wilson Rd.
Follow the rest of the instructions above.

General Rules: All dogs must be on leash or in vehicle at all times!

1. **THIS IS A SCHOOLING SHOW.** Schooling in your class is allowed and will be scored accordingly. However, horses that are disrupting other exhibitors in your class will be asked to stand in the middle of the ring.
2. Schooling equipment such as snaffle bits, bosals, running martingales, splint boots, etc. are allowed in all classes, but must be safe and humane. No draw reins, tie downs, or mechanical hackamores are allowed.
3. Riders should be neatly attired with long sleeve shirts, long jeans or breeches, and boots but may be casual. Helmets are required when riding hunt and are recommended for all. Show attire is allowed but will not count over a neat, casual look.
4. Ribbons will be awarded to 5 places in each class.
5. High Point and Reserve High Point awards will be given in each division. Halter will count but is not required. Must enter at least 3 classes in that division.
6. Exhibitor's age is as of January 1, 2020. No stallions may be shown by anyone less than 19 years of age.
7. Exhibitors in 4-H Medals must be currently enrolled in the Skagit county 4H program and registered with the Medals Chairman. Contact Lola Whitford at sqpaints@frontier.com for information and forms. Medals information is also located on the Skagit 4-H Horse Program page on Facebook in the files and at: <http://sqpaints.com/resources/ewExternalFiles/Medals%20Handbook-1.pdf> Registration form is the last page of the handbook. 4-H approved attire is required in medals classes.
8. Classes that do not fill may be canceled or combined at management's discretion. Points earned in combined classes will go to the appropriate division.
9. **HALTER:** judged on the conformation of the horse only. Grand Champion & Reserve will be chosen from the first and second place horses from classes 27, 28 & 29.
10. Class #65, 1 & 2 year old In Hand Trail, no cross entry with trail under saddle classes.
11. A **JUNIOR HORSE** is born in 2015 or later. A **SENIOR HORSE** is born in 2014 or before.
12. **RANCH CLASSES** will roughly follow SHTX rules (stockhorsetexas.org)
13. No cross entry between Walk-Trot classes and classes that lope/canter in the same division. Exhibitors may lope western and walk/trot english or canter english and walk/jog western.
